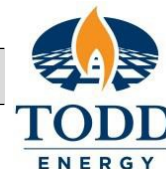

CAUTION: Insulation Fibres that have been exposed to prolonged high temperature in excess of 850°C, (heaters and stress relievers) can become crystalline in nature and should be treated in similar fashion to asbestos ie: contain and wear the appropriate respirator. Barriers and signs have been erected to prohibit passage of other personnel within the work area.
